- Thursday, May 08, 2025: Engaging with Federal Government
- Thursday, May 15, 2025: Connecting with Advocacy Groups & Graduation

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Aroostook Civic Academy? The Aroostook Civic Academy is an intensive six-day course designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills needed to understand public policy and become effective advocates for their communities.

Who can apply to this program? Aroostook County residents aged 18 and older who are passionate about advocacy <u>and</u> who can attend all six sessions are encouraged to apply. Due to limited space, applications will be reviewed to create a diverse cohort. While priority is given to applicants aged 60 and over, up to 50% of the participants may be under 60.

What can I look forward to gaining from this experience? Participants will gain valuable insights by learning from experts in the field, interacting with elected and appointed officials, mastering strategies to navigate government institutions, and building lasting connections with peers.

Do I have to attend all days of the course to participate? Yes, full participation is expected. Each session introduces new topics that build upon one another. In-person attendance is required to fully benefit from the program.

What is the time commitment for this program? The program consists of six sessions held on Thursdays this Spring from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Participants are encouraged to prepare in advance and may have follow-up activities after each session. The total time commitment may vary based on your level of engagement and interest.

Where is this program located? This year, sessions will be held in Presque Isle and at several Agency Access Points across northern Maine, providing convenient options based on your location.

Will lunch/refreshments be provided? Yes, refreshments and lunch will be provided at each session location.
